**Sub: Request to furnish detailed report – thereof.**

Sir,

The Manipur Commission for Protection of Child Rights (MCPCR) is a statutory body empowered by the Commission for Protection of Child Rights Act (CPCR Act), 2005 to monitor the entitlement to rights and safeguard for children provided in the Constitution and laws of the country and u/s 13 1 (j) to enquire into complaints and take suo motu notice of matter relating to deprivation and violation of child rights; non-implementation of laws providing for protection and development of children and non-compliance of policy decisions, guidelines or instructions aimed at mitigating hardships to and ensuring welfare of the children and to provide relief to such children.

2. The State Commission has taken up a suo motu cognizance of an incident occurred yesterday i.e., on 26/06/2024 at Imphal airport to Keishampat portion of Tiddim Road, Imphal West, which were uploaded on various social media platforms and published in local print and electronic media as well. The MCPCR duly acknowledged the challenges encountered by police personnel conducting the operation i.e., to intercept and apprehend of an accused who was found accompanied by his children. However, we are all legally bound to follow laws and norms while discharging our duties, and certain protocols relating to children could not be bypassed while dealing with such crucial situations where children are found with the accused.

3. The incident was related with fierce scuffle between a person namely Moirangthem Tomtomsana @ Nongsaba of Heirok village with a team of police who were bringing him in a vehicle from Imphal airport. The minor daughter and minor son of the above person were seen running amid the crowded traffic while crying for safe release of their father and got momentary fainting as a result of the violent scene they witnessed.

4. It is therefore requested to furnish a detailed factual report of the incident to the Commission within 5 (five) days of the receipt of this letter.
